Program Requirements

Foreign Language Requirement

In order to fulfill the foreign language requirement, native speakers of English must have accomplished one of the following:

- Complete 15 hours of a second language or 5 hours of intermediate or advanced modern language with a minimum grade of C.
- Obtain an Intermediate level Rating on the ACTFL Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI). For more information on the OPI, visit the website at www.actfl.org.

International Experience Requirement

Students from the U.S. must have an international experience to qualify for the M.S. in International Studies degree. The time outside the U.S. must be a minimum of 3 to 6 weeks, involve a structured program of course work or internship and have occurred during the student's undergraduate or graduate programs. Due to the great variety of opportunities, the experience must be approved by the director.
